



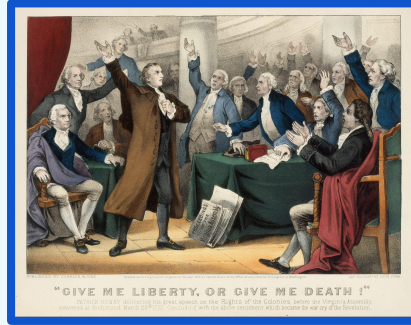

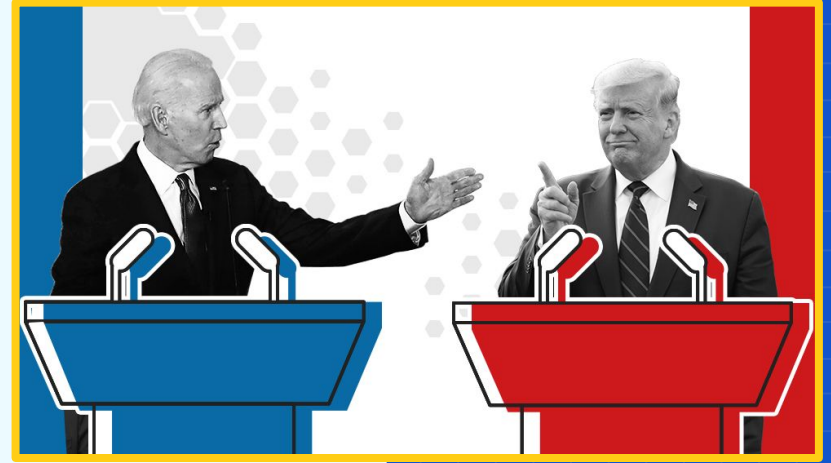
What is a debate?

Verb:

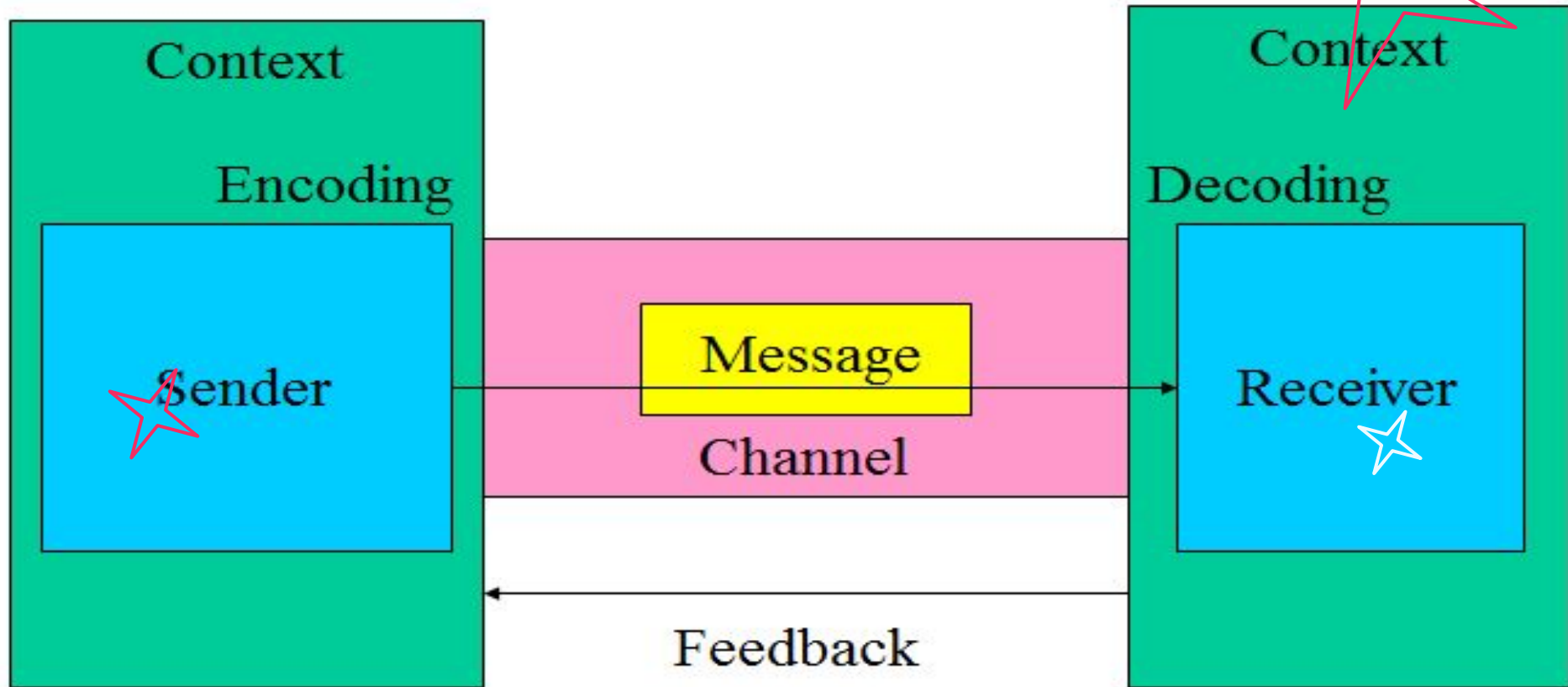
To argue about (a subject), especially in a formal manner.

Noun:

a formal discussion containing opposing arguments



How to Structure an Argument





Process



Consider

Think about the situation :
the sender,
receiver,
medium



Clarify

Clarify your
thinking, think
about pros and
cons



Construct

Construct a
claim that
states your
opinion



Confirm

Use reasoning
and evidence
to support and
confirm your
claim

Evidence

In my opinion...

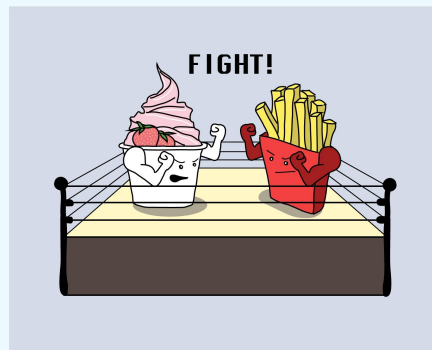

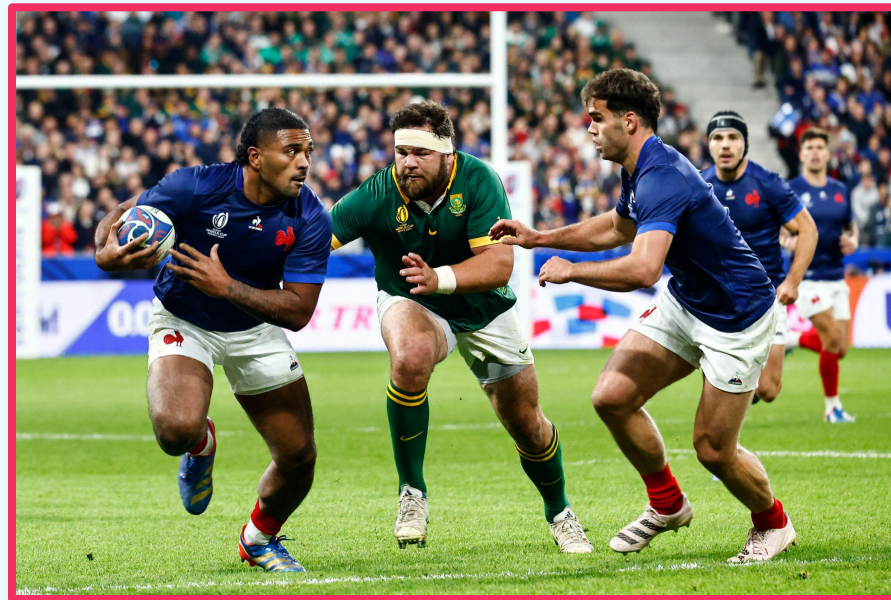
